### **DIRECTIONS:**

## **CARPETS** - Blot up any spillage before cleaning:

- Step 1. Spray That's Awesome Stain Remover directly over stain in small section.
- Step 2. Using dry toweling cloth, rub slowly in a forward/backwards motion, one small section at a time (do not rub hard or in circular motion as this may damage the carpet fibre).
- **Step 3.** Check cloth for transfer of stain, then turn cloth and continue (repeat steps 1 & 2 if necessary).

#### WALLS & DOORS - Scuff Marks:

- Step 1. Mist spray That's Awesome Stain Remover over approx. 1m² on walls & doors for daily grime, then wipe with dry toweling cloth (repeat if necessary).
- **Step 2.** To remove scuff marks, spray directly on marks and, using light scrub or similar, lightly scrub to remove. Wipe with dry toweling cloth. (Check first in incon spicuous area for paint transfer).

### **UPHOLSTERY** - Fabric or Macro Suede, etc.:

- Step 1. Vacuum upholstery.
- **Step 2.** Spray liberally over stains of section of upholstery (e.g. seat pad or arm rest).
- **Step 3.** Brush area with soft brush then scrape fabric (gently) with plastic card, gum tool or similar.
- **Step 4.** Rub out dirt/stain with dry toweling cloth (repeat if necessary).

# Keep out of reach of children
